# **One Big Solution Winner!**

Big-thinkers from Hartlebury CE Primary School beat off strong competition to scoop first place in a contest with their solution to the global scourge of litter pollution. The annual Big Idea competition, run for primary schools within the Wyre Forest-based Severn Academies Educational Trust, invited pupils to choose a world-wide problem and come up with plans to solve it. The Hartlebury team wowed the judges with their teamwork and plans for robot litter pickers and won £1,000 for their school.

Teams of children from Years 3 and 4 from the trust's six primary schools spent a day identifying, discussing and solving issues including famine, climate change and mental health and wellbeing. Each school team was supported by their two Year 6 Trust Council leaders, who helped to guide them.

Judges, including environmental expert Daisy Askins, from Astley Skylarks, trust chair of trustees Wendy Taylor and senior trust officials, chose Hartlebury as the stand-out group. Organiser Ian James, Executive Headteacher of St Bartholomew's CE Primary School, said: "It was a tough decision as all the teams showed great understanding, excellent teamwork and came up with a host of super solutions."



The other schools taking part were Far Forest Lea Memorial CE Primary Academy, Stourport Primary Academy, Wilden All Saints CE Primary School and Wolverley Sebright Primary Academy. Well done Hartlebury.... We are so proud to have won!

#### **Sports Morning – Friday 5th July**

#### **Summer Reminders**

With the Summer Term now in full swing, we are looking forward to some good weather, continuing our outdoor learning on our fabulous field and in Forest School. The children will be making full use of these facilities, making dens, exploring our adventure equipment and enjoying lots of sporting activities. Consequently, here are a few reminders:

<u>Covering legs and arms for Forest School</u> Please consider the clothes your children wear for Forest School; there are nettles and brambles in this area so covered arms and legs are advised. Class teachers will inform parents if children have a slot booked in Forest school this term.



<u>Sunhats and Sun Cream</u> Please send your child into school with sun cream already applied and a sun hat or cap when it is appropriate for the weather.

<u>Water Bottles</u> Please ensure your child always has a water bottle in school. They will be allowed water to drink whenever they require it during the school day. We ask that the children limit their intake of sugary drinks and request they have sugar free squash at lunch and break times only.
