The Worcestershire Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme is back for winter 2024!

During the school holidays, eligible families can book FREE holiday activities, family passes and events

through the programme. Funded by the Department for Education, HAF is primarily for children in receipt of benefits related to Free School Meals aged 5-16, however, the programme does support other children and young people otherwise considered vulnerable (including LAC, SEND and refugee status).

Families can search and book activities through the HAF booking site. School holidays can be a difficult time for families, we want to make sure the HAF Programme reaches as many of those who need it as possible.
